Datum was approached by London-based Interior designer David Bentheim to carry out a refurbishment of an impressive ground floor apartment in south west London for a private client.

The contract consisted of stripping out the existing kitchen, doors, frames and flooring throughout, before carrying out some complex structural work to enlarge the size of the door openings to create a number of full height double door openings.

The 10-week project included all plastering, decorating, plumbing and electrical installation; it involved replacing 250mm high skirting to match the existing as well as supplying and installing bespoke joinery and door linings to receive 'Crittle' metal framed and glazed doors throughout. A new solid oak floor was also laid throughout the flat.

New Stationery Department for Liberty London

We were delighted when we were appointed to fit-out the new Stationery Department on the ground floor at Liberty London, which had to be completed in just 10 days,

In order to maintain customer access from the main store entrance on the corner of Great Marlborough Street, a temporary trading area was set up on the back of our hoarding as the internal partitions — that formed storage areas behind the company's famous window displays — were removed to increase the trading area. The additional floor area received new stone tiles, with a rustic period appearance, which were let in to the existing timber floor that was retained.

An original floor-to-ceiling stone fireplace was uncovered during the stripout stage, which Liberty London decided to retain, reflecting an important part of the building's heritage. The stonework was cleaned and the fireplace now forms an impressive feature in the department.

New perimeter display panelling and shelving was installed, together with a number of individual pieces of period furniture added as display tables.

Commenting on the project, which was completed on schedule, David Round of Datum said: "We were delighted with the completed scheme." which has created a new, fresh interior that remains sympathetic to the fine architecture of this magnificent and unique building."
